WE FOLLOW A 10 WEEK TERM



Our Term 3 (10 weeks) is highlighted

We understand that some schools follow different calendars.

As we proudly tutor over 150 students each week, this means that our students attend different school systems (public, independent, Catholic etc.).

Due to this wide variation, at We, Future Leaders, we follow a strict **10 week term, four times a year**, outlined in our proposals that families sign.

Please see the calendar above for our term 3 enrolment period, which has these 10 weeks **highlighted**.

For pausing or changing services, we require 2 weeks' notice, also outlined in our proposals.
